

Strengthening Pakistan's Human Development through Public-Private Synergy

Milestone Public-Private Partnership: PHDF and NCHD in a groundbreaking collaboration, to forge a powerful partnership that has transformed the landscape of Pakistan's development sector over the past 22 years. The financial base was provided by the huge contribution made by all the founding and the sustaining directors. So far, a total of 1.6 billion grants and donation have been raised by PHDF. It was replenished with donation and then a public endowment fund to join hands with Public Sector. Through the National Commission for Human Development (NCHD), while creating a firewall for channelization of funds and resources PHDF has achieved remarkable milestones in the field of Primary education, Adult Literacy, Community health, literacy, Skill Development, Women Empowerment and community development, while touching the lives of millions of destitute across Pakistan.

In Adult Literacy 1,73,854 Literacy Centers were established wherein 1.4 million adult learners graduated. In order to cater the need of out of school children who have crossed the age of 11 years 3000 ALC's in 117 Districts of Pakistan were established wherein 7500 illiterates were made literate. PHDF feeling its responsibility for all the segments of society opened ALC in 110 Jails across Pakistan. In order to introduce Contemporary Education (Computer, Science, Math and Englis) 100 Diini Madaris were selected across Pakistan wherein 100 Computers were provided for the enlightenment of the Madrasa Students. In another concerted effort 5770 feeder Schools were established in past two decades wherein 310241 learners were graduated. In the field of Primary health women were taught ORS preparation and immunization of Women against tetanus whereon 14.87 (m) were spent. Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation provide a grant of 6 million US dollars for this ORS projects. 44000 children were provided with glasses. With a presence in 42 districts, PHDF in collaboration with NCHD has mobilized a dedicated force of 204891 volunteers across Pakistan, creating a robust network of change-makers who has performed tremendously in all the disastrous (Earthquake, IDP, Flood and Tree Plantation Drive) committed to driving progress and prosperity. These initiatives have contributed significantly to Pakistan's development, with significant increasing in literacy rate.

The partnership has enabled PHDF and NCHD to:

- Reach marginalized communities and vulnerable populations
- Promote health awareness and improve healthcare outcomes
- Empower women and girls through education and economic opportunities
- Foster a culture of volunteerism and community service
